This writ petition has been preferred for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to deliver the physical possession of Flat No. 1290-GF-EWS Housing Board Colony, Sector-5, Hansi, which, according to the petitioner, was allotted to her on 03.06.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the petitioner asserts that the petitioner has been approaching the respondents, all through, for permitting her to deposit the remaining amount and for handing over the physical possession of the flat, as allotted to her, but without any response.

Petitioner, at the end, has served a legal notice through counsel dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-6), which was duly served upon the respondents, but till date, no reply has been received. Counsel asserts that the petitioner, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the

Chief Administrator, Housing Board Haryana, Panchkula-respondent No. 3 to consider and take a decision on the legal notice within some specified time.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pravindra S. Chauhan, Sr. Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the writ petition with directions to the Chief Administrator, Housing Board Haryana, Panchkula-respondent No. 3 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 06.12.2022 (Annexure P-6) served by the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today. Decision, so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential relief be granted to her, on completion of the requisite formalities, within a period of four weeks thereafter.
