In compliance of the last order, the petitioner, respondent No. 6, Ms. Ankita Malhotra, Advocate and Ms. Sudha Kumari, Advocate are present in Court during court proceedings.

Yesterday, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the petitioner, respondent No. 6, Ms. Ankita Malhotra, Advocate and Ms. Sudha Kumari, Advocate had levelled allegations and counter allegations against each other. However, today, the Court was informed that they all had settled their disputes amicably. Even, the statements of Poonam Sood petitioner, Harjot Kaur respondent No. 6, Ms. Ankita Malhotra Advocate and Ms. Sudha Kumari Advocate have been recorded on oath and the same are taken on record. All the above said persons have stated that they had amicably resolved their disputes and had no grouse against each other. They would also withdraw the

complaint/case/application, filed by them and in case any such complaint, case and application is found pending, the same shall be deemed to be withdrawn. All of them have already undertaken that they will not post any message with regard to each other on any social media platform and shall also withdraw the message, if already posted. They further undertake that they will not contact each other in future and shall live peacefully. The respective statements made by above said four persons shall form part of this order as well and they shall remain bound by the statements made by them on oath.

Since, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties and they have decided to live peacefully, no further orders are required and the petition is, accordingly disposed off.
