The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.158 dated 02.04.2022 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 23.01.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and he has paid a sum of Rs.35,000/- in cash to the complainant who is present in Court without prejudice to his rights during the course of the Trial.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 23.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 23.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
