The instant petition has been filed seeking extension of parole, as had been granted to him vide order dated 26.12.2022 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that while he had been granted parole on account of death of his father, as of now his mother is critical and is hospitalized and is on ventilator.

Vide order dated 19.1.2023, this Court had directed the State to verify the assertions of the petitioner as regards the ailment of his mother.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Rohan Singh Hooda, Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Kurukshetra, accompanied by a verification report, as per which the petitioner's mother is indeed critically ill and is hospitalized since 12.1.2023 and is on ventilator support.

In view of the aforestated position, this Court is of the opinion that the parole already granted to the petitioner can be extended. The petition, as such, is accepted and the parole already granted to the petitioner is extended by two weeks. The petitioner after availing parole shall surrender before the Jail Authorities, concerned, on the morning of 07.2.2023.

Needless to mention, the petitioner shall make necessary arrangements to take care of his mother during the said period and no further application for extension of parole shall be entertained.
