1. Petitioner is seeking regular bail in the case bearing FIR No.238 dated 11.10.2022, under Sections 25(1) (a)-48-2019 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind.

2. Briefly, the case pertains to recovery under Arms Act. The petitioner had sought interim bail as his wife was on family way. It was submitted that the wife of the petitioner has delivered a baby girl on 05.02.2023 through cesarean section and accordingly, he was granted interim bail from 14.02.2023 to 28.02.2023 in terms of order dated 13.02.2023. Subsequently, the interim bail was extended till 15.03.2023 vide order dated 01.03.2023 on the score that the wife of the petitioner was still required to be taken to hospital for dressing on alternate days and medical certificate was also produced in this regard. The petitioner was released on interim bail and was required to surrender before the jail authorities on 16.03.2023 but he has not surrendered till date.

3. The report has been received from learned trial Court which indicates that non-bailable warrants of the petitioner are being issued.

4. Keeping in view that the petitioner has misused the concession of interim bail and has not surrendered within the prescribed time frame, the petitioner becomes disentitled for bail.
