The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to amend the final result dated 22.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) and 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-4), published for the posts of Craft Instructor (Women) (Dress Making) (Practical), in pursuance of the advertisement No.12/2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had applied for the said post; that the petitioner who has lost her father, suffers with 100% disability; that as per the final result dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner had secured 43 marks; that however in the final result, experience certificate (Annexure P-5) of the petitioner was not considered, and that the last candidate shown to be in the waiting list for SC Category, had secured 44 marks. Learned counsel further contends that out of 05 posts reserved for the candidates of SC Category, 03 posts are still lying vacant, and that in case the petitioner is allotted marks on the

basis of her experience certificate (Annexure P-5), she would certainly fall in the waiting list prepared for the candidates of SC Category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before respondent No.2 by way of filing a representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-7), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 02.01.2023 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
