Instant petition has been filed under Section 482, Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR No.202 dated 28.07.2020, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 420, IPC, at Police Station City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur, Annexure P-1, and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 21.08.2020, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the dispute has been amicably settled by the parties. He seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition with liberty to seek quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, if any, arrived at between the parties.
