The present petition has been filed for grant of Regular Bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.82 dated 03.11.2019, u/s 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Balachour, District SBS Nagar.

Reply filed in the Court, is taken on record.

In paragraph 9 of the bail petition, the petitioner declares no history. As per State counsel submission, one more case is pending against the petitioner.

After arguing for some time and realising that the Court is not inclined to grant bail, counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file fresh one.
