1. Prayer in the present 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.244 dated 25.09.2022 under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC, 1860 and Section 24 of Immigration Act, registered at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.
- 2 Vide order dated 17.07.2023, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 17.07.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has produced a photocopy of the receipt of costs of Rs.25,000/- deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Clerks' Association. The learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ravinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.
4. In view of the above, interim order dated 17.07.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
5. The present petition stands disposed off.
