1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for quashing of the order dated 07.11.2019 (Annexure P-6), passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender in FIR No.440 dated 03.09.2017, registered under Sections 323, 324, 336, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel representing the respondent-State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Bharat Bhushan, submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as all accused including the present petitioner have been acquitted vide judgment dated 31.01.2023, passed by the Judicial
