1. The present civil revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of the order dated 12.07.2016 (Annexure P-7) whereby the plaintiff-petitioner has been directed to make good the deficiency in Court fee by paying ad-valorem Court fee.

2. Learned counsels for the respondents have produced a copy of order dated 18.12.2019 passed by Ld. Additional Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Mansa whereby it has been ordered that suit has already been disposed of being abated under Order 22 Rule 3 CPC. The same is taken on record. They further submit that since main suit has already been disposed of, the revision petition has become rendered infructuous.

3. Accordingly, the present revision petition stands dismissed as having become infructuous.
