Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.90 dated 14.10.2022 registered under Sections 341, 506, 326, 324, 325, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Kotli Surat Malli, District Batala.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed and the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation with the police.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury caused by the petitioner with the *datar* is covered under Section 325 IPC which is a bailable offence and further, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and

got effected recovery of the weapon and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.1.2023 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
