The present revision petition has been filed by the petitioner for setting aside the order dated 28.05.2014, whereby an application filed by the petitioner under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condonation of delay in filing the first appeal, has been dismissed by the First Appellate Court of learned Additional District Judge, Patiala and consequently, his appeal has not been heard and ex parte judgment and decree dated 10.04.2009, passed by the trial Court, has been upheld.
