This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to take legal action against respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the petitioner has not given any representation to respondent No.2, thus, he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving an appropriate representation to respondent No.2.
