The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No. 15 dated 09.01.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 IPC (Sections 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt., District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Rana admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case. However, recovery of some cash amount is still to be effected.

In view of aforesaid factual position, no case for custodial interrogation is made out. Therefore, the interim order dated 19.07.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
