Learned counsel for both the parties submit that the petition moved by the petitioner-husband under Section 127 Cr.P.C (for short 'the petition') for seeking reduction in the amount of the maintenance allowance, as directed by the Competent Court to be paid to the respondents vide its order dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-1), is pending adjudication before the Family Court at Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib and has reached the stage of hearing the arguments and the final decision thereof and the third Execution Application (for short 'the E.A.') filed by the respondents, is also pending in the concerned Executing Court.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner-husband prays that the instant revision petition may be disposed of with a direction to the

Family Court concerned to decide the above-said petition within some specific time frame and as regards the dispute between the parties qua the payment of the arrears of maintenance allowance allegedly outstanding against the petitioner-husband, the parties may agitate the same in the E.A. pending before the Executing Court and the proceedings in the said E.A. be stayed till the decision of the afore-said petition by the Family Court.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the above-discussed prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Resultantly, the revision petition in hand is hereby disposed of in the afore-said terms with a direction to the Family Court concerned to decide the said petition under Section 127 Cr.P.C, as pending before it, in accordance with law, within a period of six (06) weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
