This is the second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.106 dated 29.12.2020, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, the petitioner is in custody since 29.12.2020.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, has submitted that out of 14 prosecution witnesses, 03 witnesses are left to be examined and the same would be examined expeditiously. Rest of the witnesses have been examined or given up.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, at this stage. It has been further stated that since the petitioner is in custody from 29.12.2020, it has been prayed that the trial Court be directed to

expedite the trial.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present regular bail petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.

The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial.
