LISA GILL, J.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines the prayer for an inquiry regarding genuineness of the educational certificate submitted by respondent No. 6, who has been elected as Sarpanch of village Hasangarh, Sub Division Sampla, District Rohtak. It is contended that educational certificate submitted by respondent No. 6 is a fake and forged document.

Learned counsel confines the prayer in this writ petition for an inquiry regarding genuineness of the Class VIII certificate submitted by respondent No. 6, in terms of Section 177 of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, 1944.

Learned counsel for the State to whom advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied, on instructions from Sh. Rohtash, Legal Officer Panchayat, Rohtak and Sub Divisional Officer (C) Sampla, District Rohtak,

submits that inquiry in this matter has already been conducted and final decision thereon shall be taken by the competent authority within the next three weeks.

In view of the statement as above, there is no justification for continuation of the present proceedings.

Writ petition is, accordingly, disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a final decision on the matter within the time frame as expressed before us.

It is clarified that there is no expression of opinion on the merits of the controversy.
