Present petition has been filed by the petitioner for quashing of impugned order dated 15.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned trial Court whereby the petitioner is ordered to be summoned through non-bailable warrants of arrest, on account of his absence.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that absence of the petitioner before the trial Court on the date fixed was not intentional and that the present case is offshoot of another FIR which was registered under Section 420, 120-B IPC and later on, the matter was compromised. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join the proceedings before the learned trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.L.Pawar, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh submits that the petitioner jumped bail before the learned trial Court and resultantly,

impugned order (Annexure P-2) has been passed.

In view of above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear before the learned trial Court within next 20 days and on doing so, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction pending trial subject to costs of Rs.5000/- which is to be deposited by the petitioner with District Legal Services Authority, Amritsar.
