VIKAS BAHL, J (ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab as well as the order dated 15.02.2021 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Commissioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed an application for correction of khasra girdwari and that matter had been remanded back by the Commissioner, vide order dated 15.02.2021 to the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Dera Baba Nanak and the said order has been upheld by the Financial Commissioner, vide order dated 02.09.2022. He further submitted that the petitioner restricts his prayer to expeditious disposal of the application filed by the petitioner for correction of

khasra girdwari, by the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Dera Baba Nanak

before whom the same is pending, after the passing of the remand order.

Learned State counsel has submitted that every effort would be made before the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, Dera Baba Nanak i.e. the competent authority, before whom the matter is pending after the remand order, would decide the case as expeditiously as possible.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority before whom the application for correction of khasra girwari is pending after the remand order, to decide the same as expeditiously as possible.
