By this common order, three writ petitions, the details of which have been given in the heading, are being decided as all these petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the grievance of the petitioners will arise in case, any of the advertised post is left vacant and the petitioners are the only eligible candidates to be considered against the said vacant posts, which situation is yet to arrive, hence, the present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage, with liberty to the petitioners to re-agitate their claim in case, any of the advertised post in the Category in which the petitioners are competing, remain vacant and there is no other candidate except the petitioners to be considered eligible for the said vacant post by filing a fresh petition on the same cause of action.
