The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been invoked for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 90, dated 29.09.2022, under Sections 379-B of the Indian Penal Code 1860, registered at Police Station City Morinda, District Roopnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations qua the petitioner is that he has snatched the purse/Wallet of the complainant containing currency notes of ₹11,000/-, Aadhar Card, PAN card, Driving License, ATM Card of Indian Bank and RC of truck bearing registration No. PB-65-L-4928.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed by learned State counsel are taken on record. According to custody certificate the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of 4 months and 26 days and he is

not involved in any another case of any nature.

Considering the facts that the investigation in the present case is complete; no recovery is to be effected form the petitioner and the period undergone by the petitioner so far, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands allowed in view of the afore-said terms.
