The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.219 dated 09.10.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 506 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 25.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Karanbir Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 25.01.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 25.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
