[1] Prayer in the petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside order (Annexure P-2) dated 10.05.2018 passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari vide which the application of the respondent-plaintiff for placing on record fresh affidavit had been allowed in a suit for recovery of Rs.2 lacs principle amount along with interest *pendente lite* and future interest @ 12 % per annum w.e.f. the date of filing of the suit till the date of actual payment with costs.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that civil suit having been withdrawn by the respondent-plaintiff on account of compromise between the parties vide order dated 12.12.2020 passed by the Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *dismissed as withdrawn*.
