The present appeal has been preferred under Section 14-A of the SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act (for short 'the Act') seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.91 dated 11.05.2022 registered under Sections 3(1)(r) of the Act and Section 506 IPC at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.01.2023, appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 20.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Parvesh Chopra, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural) has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.
