DEEPAK GUPTA, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.154 dated 29.03.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 392, 506 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (later on offence under Section 392 of IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act was deleted and offence under Section 395, 411 IPC and Section 28-54-59 of Arms Act was added) registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

Allegations are that on 29.03.2022 bag containing ₹1,50,000/- hung on the shoulder of the complainant Parveen Kumar was snatched by three persons who had come on a bike. FIR was registered. The CCTV cameras installed nearby were checked. The suspected persons were joined in the investigation. Initially untrace report was filed on 08.08.2022. Later on, Sanju @ Dholia was arrested on 07.10.2022 and it is alleged that in his disclosure statement he not only admitted his own involvement but also nominated petitioner to be one of the snatchers.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner has been falsely implicated; that no Test Identification Parade was

ever conducted; that recovery of ₹1,500/- and a toy pistol has been shown from the petitioner.

Custody certificate, reply along with the copy of the orders whereby petitioner was allowed bail in other cases has been placed on record by learned State counsel.

As per the custody certificate placed on record, petitioner is in custody for last 4 months and 5 days. Although he is involved in many other cases but he is on bail in all those cases as is evident from the custody certificate.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
