This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 6 to supply the report No.66 dated 06.07.2022 as mentioned in Annexure P-7.

Learned State counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 7 and has submitted that the said report No.66 dated 06.07.2022 would be supplied by respondent No.6 to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today on the petitioner depositing the necessary fees.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.6 to supply a copy of the report No.66 dated 06.07.2022 to the petitioner within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order and after taking the necessary fees.

It would be open to the petitioner to seek appropriate remedy against the persons, who had taken the loan against his property, in accordance with law.
