Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.240 dated 20.05.2022 under Sections 17-B/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Sections 332/353/186/193/120-B of IPC, 1860 (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on) registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 23.01.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 23.01.2023 petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Shekhar Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 23.01.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
