1. The challenge in the instant revision petition is to the order dated 20.07.2018 (Annexure P-12) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Samrala whereby an application filed by the plaintiff/petitioner to examine the witness namely Tehal Singh s/o Calcutta Singh r/o Machhiwara, Tehsil Samrala, District Ludhiana through video conferencing has been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits at the time of passing of impugned order dated 20.07.2018 Tehal Singh s/o Calcutta Singh was residing at Canada but now he is in India and can be examined on the next date of hearing before the trial Court.
