Reply to the petition by the State has not been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner was earlier granted bail by the trial Court vide order dated 18.04.2019 (Annexure P-2). He further states that challan was presented and charges were framed. The petitioner did not appear in the Court due to communication gap, thereafter bail order was cancelled and non-bailable warrant of arrest was issued against him. The non-bailable warrant was not executed as the petitioner was not residing at the address given in the petition and left the village. Thereafter, proclamation was issued. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Court below.

On asking, learned State counsel states that recovery in this case is less than the commercial quantity.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court on or before 04.02.2023 and move an application in this regard. If such an

application is filed, then, he shall be granted bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
