JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.(ORAL)

On 24.01.2023 the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ *The prayer in the present petition is for quashing of impugned order dated 09.12.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by Sessions Judge, Mansa whereby the bail bonds and bail orders of the petitioner stood forfeited to the State.*

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that he was regularly facing the trial since the year 2015. However, on one date i.e. 16.09.2022 he absented himself which lead to the passing of the impugned order. He submits that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

*Notice of motion for **16.03.2023.***

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.20,000/- as costs with Sadhna Society for Mentally Handicapped Near Housing Board Chowk, Raen Basera Building, Manimarja, Sector 13, Chandigarh he shall be admitted to interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.”

At the time of hearing, the Counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance with the aforesaid order dated 24.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has been granted bail as is evident from the order dated 30.01.2023 passed by SDJM Sardulgarh.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from the proceedings in future.
