This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directions to respondent No.2 to take action against respondent No.5 for misappropriation of MGNEGA Funds by initiating action against respondent No.5 under Section 20 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act, 1994.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Ms. Ravneet Kaur, BDPO, Dera Bassi, has submitted that in pursuance of the show cause notice dated 12.07.2022 (Annexure P-4), the proceedings are pending against respondent No.5 and a final decision regarding the same would be taken as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within a period of two months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that on account of the said statement made by learned State counsel, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such.
