The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 & 2 to initiate enquiry and to take action against respondent No.3.

Learned State counsel has informed on instructions from Ms. Shally, Senior Assistant, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Punjab that the inquiry into the allegations levelled by the petitioner against respondent No.3 had been conducted and the same were found to be unsubstantiated and false.

The matter has, thereafter, been adjourned successively on 11.05.2022, 02.08.2022, 10.10.2022 as well as on 17.01.2023. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing despite the case having been called twice. The position has remained the same today as well. It seems that the petitioner is no more

interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
