Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the order of allotment/lease (Annexure P-2) in respect of the land forming part of the kabristan/graveyard land passed by respondents No.2 and 3 in favour of respondent No.4 and directing the respondents not to interfere in the possession and user of dedication and not to demolish grave yards and construction and not to raise new construction thereon as the lease deed of allotment (Annexure P-2) is void and having no force in the eyes of law and have no effect on the rights of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that the possession of the property has been handed over to the Wakf Board rendering the present petition as infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also affirmed the above-said fact.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present case which has been rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as infructuous.
