1. Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside sale notice dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P1) issued by the respondent – Bank.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent – Bank, on instructions from Mr. Ajay Aggarwal, Branch Manager, Canara Bank informs that this writ petition is rendered infructuous as the petitioners' account has been settled and closed.
3. None appears on behalf of the petitioner. However, we do not find any justification for continuance of the present proceedings, in view of categorical statement made by learned counsel for the respondent – bank.
