This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents to grant protection of life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 23.12.2022 (Annexure P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection for his life and liberty.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such

representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
