GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to provide adequate security to the petitioners for the purpose of attending hearing at Bathinda due to threat as the same at the instance of respondent No.6, who is stated to be posted as SHO, Police Station NRI, Bathinda.

It is submitted that on account of some matrimonial differences between petitioner No.1 and respondent No.8, some cases came to be instituted by respondent No.8 against the petitioners, the details of which are mentioned in the reply filed by the State and the same is as under:-

“A. *FIR No.8 dated 22.03.2021 under Sections 498A, 406, 506 IPC was got registered by respondent No.8 (petitioner’s wife) at Police Station Women Bathinda against petitioners.*

B. *CRM-596/2022 titled ‘Veerpal Kaur vs. Dalvinder Singh’-*

application u/s 125 Cr.P.C is pending before Ld. Family Court, Bathinda.

C. *Application u/s 12 Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is pending in the Ld. Court of Ms. Tanvi Gupta, JMIC, Bathinda against petitioners.”*

A perusal of reply would indicate that necessary steps have been taken by the police to provide protection to the petitioners as and when they have to appear in the Court at Bathinda.

In view of above, no further directions are required to be issued, at this stage. However, Senior Superintendent of Police-respondent No.4 is directed to ensure that the order dated 13.03.2023, which is stated to have already passed pertaining to security to the petitioners, be duly complied with in letter and spirit and that advance intimation be sought from the petitioners regarding the date when they have to appear in the Court at Bathinda so that there is no lapse in security.

In the light of above, the present petition is disposed of.
