Learned counsel representing the State submits that the competent authority will consider the claim of the petitioners in terms of the provisions contained in the Punjab Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes (Reservation in Services) Act, 2006.

Learned counsel representing the petitioners has no objection if the competent authority re-considers the matter within a specified time period.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide the matter within a period of one month, after granting opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties. Needless to observe that if the petitioners still feel aggrieved, they shall be at liberty to file a fresh petition.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
