Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in their peaceful life from the hands of respondent No.4 as both are both are major and are staying with their own will in live-in-relationship.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that both the petitioners are major and are living in live-in-relationship against the wishes of respondent no.4 and have sought protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent no.4. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 20.01.2023 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2.

Notice of motion to respondents no.1 to 3-State only.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Panipat, District Panipat, Haryana to decide the representation (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and grant them protection if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them. This order would not be understood as having expressed any opinion whatsoever by this Court on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners.
