Instant petition has been filed primarily seeking the following
reliefs:-

“(iv) Issue a writ in the nature of Certiorari to
quash the punishment order dated 30.07.2012 (Annexure P-4)
and appellate order dated 19.03.2014 (Annexure P-5) to the
extent of upholding the punishment, in the interest of justice.

(v) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus
directing the respondents to decide the appeal of the petitioner
dated 23.04.2014 (Annexure P-6), reminder dated 08.06.2016
(Annexure P-7) and reminder dated 19.03.2018 (Annexure P-
8).”

By making a reference to the response filed on behalf of the official respondents, State counsel submits that during the pendency of the instant writ petition, second appeal preferred by the petitioner has been dismissed vide order dated 02.07.2019, Annexure R-1, which has not been challenged by the petitioner. It is his submission that the punishment order and the order passed by the First Appellate Authority have merged in the order, Annexure R-1.

In view of above, nothing survives in the petition, which is hereby dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge order, Annexure R-1, in accordance with law.
