The present petition has been filed for seeking quashing of the order passed by respondent No.2-Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. allowing the supply of electricity to the adjacent factory from the petitioner's personal transformer.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents No.2 and 4 had informed that the reasons for the petitioner to approach this Court was that the application filed for seeking injunction was not being decided by the Civil Court at Narnaul on account of the then prevailing COVID circumstances even though the Civil Suit was filed way back in the January, 2022. It is informed that the interim application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 has already been decided by the Civil Court vide order dated 14.11.2022 in favour of the petitioner. Hence, the urgency

for filing the present petition has ceased to exist and the substantive dispute is already pending adjudication before the Civil Court.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case the aforesaid factual aspects are found to be incorrect.
