AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 8, dated 14th January, 2023, under Sections 341, 307, 323, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

2. On 27th January, 2023, parties were directed to get their statements recorded. The report of trial Court dated 3rd March, 2023 was received stating that parties had not appeared for getting their statement recorded. On 4th July, 2023, another opportunity was granted for getting their statement recorded, subject to costs of Rs.2500/-. As per the report dated 24th August, 2023, parties have failed to appear for recording of the statement.

3. *Inspite* of two pass overs, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. The factum of the compromise is doubtful. The petition is dismissed at this stage.

4. Since the main case has been dismissed, pending application if any is rendered infructuous.
