By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and hand over the enquiry/investigation of case FIR No.253 dated 16.09.2018 to some senior police official.

Learned State counsel representing respondents No.1 to 3 submits that in the aforementioned FIR, the trial Court has already concluded the trial resulting into conviction of almost 6 accused vide judgment dated 29.03.2022 passed by the Court learned Additional Sessions Judge, Chandigarh and thus, the present petition be rendered infructuous in view of the aforesaid.

Once the trial is over resulting into conviction of almost 6 accused arrayed in the FIR, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous.
