AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the court concerned for expeditious disposal of objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, 'the Act') as also the execution petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly submits that during the pendency of the petition, objections under Section 34 of the Act have been decided.

From the pleadings, it is forthcoming that the petitioners have not approached the executing court with a prayer for expeditious disposal.

No interference is called for in the petition.

The petition is dismissed.

There is no doubt that in the eventuality of petitioners approaching the executing court for expeditious disposal, the same would be considered in accordance with law.
