Prayer is made for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.84, dated 24.08.2022, registered at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, District Batala, under Sections 341, 379-B of IPC.

Allegations are that three persons stopped the complainant Gurmej Singh on 24.08.2022 and after assaulting him took away of ₹4,000/- and his mobile phone. After registration of FIR, snatched mobile phone was put on surveillance and the same was found being used by the petitioner. Snatched mobile was recovered from the petitioner.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in fact the mobile phone recovered from the petitioner had been purchased by him from Akashdeep S/o Kuldeep Singh, which fact was disclosed to the police at the time when he was arrested. He has placed on record the affidavit of Manpreet Kaur wife of the petitioner in this regard.

As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody in this case for the last 5 months and 15 days. He has no criminal antecedent. Trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
