The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0248 dated 05.10.2022 under Section 379, 427 IPC and Section 21 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957 registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.02.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 09.02.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.02.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
