MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

This is second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.117 dated 26.06.2020 for the offences under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148, 149, 294 IPC registered at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana.

On a pointed query put to the learned counsel for the petitioner as to how successive petitions for anticipatory bail were maintainable since the previous petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. was dismissed on 06.01.2021, he has failed to satisfy this Court qua the same and has only submitted that the matter stands compromised between the parties.

It would be relevant to point out here that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant was attacked by the petitioner with an iron daat due to which he sustained incised wound on his forehead, whereupon 24 stitches were put. The said injury was opined to be dangerous to life by the doctor. Besides this, the complainant also received other injuries at the hands of other accused who were armed with sticks.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, this Court is not inclined to entertain this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
