This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.1 and also quashing of order of suspension dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that in the present case, the tenure of the petitioner has elapsed and thus, the Civil Writ Petition has been rendered infructuous.
