Instant Writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to consider application dated 27.10.2020, Annexure P-3, for appointing the petitioner in Government service on compassionate ground on account of death of his father while discharging the official duty.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's father, Rakesh Kumar, who was posted as Home Guard Volunteer, unfortunately expired during the course of discharge of duty. He submits that despite an assurance given by the respondents, as is reflected in the news report, Annexure P-4, petitioner has not been provided with an employment.

Counsel submits that petitioner's mother, Sonwati, submitted an application dated 27.10.2020, Annexure P-3, to the District Commandant, Home Guard, Palwal-respondent No.3, which is pending and the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent concerned to look into the application.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a response from the respondent.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties, but without examining the claim of the petitioner, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the application, Annexure P-3, submitted by the petitioner's mother in accordance with law within a period of 4 months from the date of communication of a copy of this order.

In case, petitioner is not found entitled to appointment, an order be passed assigning reasons for rejection.
