The present petition has been filed under Section of 482 of Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the respondent on the basis of the complaint dated 29.01.2022 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4 submits that the vehicle of the petitioner was repossessed by following the due process of law.

Still further the respondent No.4 has already initiated the proceedings under Section 17 (1) (ii) (a) and (d) of the Arbitration and

Conciliation Act, 1996 before the Arbitral Tribunal of Sh. Vinod Kumar Attri, Sole Arbitrator, Jalandhar and the dispute is pending there.

In view of the, above facts, no further directions are required in the present case.

Both the parties shall be at liberty to raise their pleas before the Arbitral Tribunal of Sh. Vinod Kumar Attri, Sole Arbitrator, Jalandhar.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of.
